

Course Description: 4-hour overview of the 2024 Edition of NFPA-70E for Electrical Safety in the Workplace. The presentation will include worker safety-related work practices, understanding OSHA Code of Federal Regulations, and safety related maintenance guidelines. This course will provide a Power Point presentation for all electricians for safety awareness and being vigilant of safety hazards when performing work on or near electrical equipment. This training will reference 2023 NFPA-70 & 2024 NFPA-70E code sections.

- Understand potential hazards in the work place when performing work on possibly energized electrical equipment.
- Understand the rules of what is a “qualified persons” performing electrical tasks
- Provide assistance to understand and recognize safety hazards on the job.
