Program Description: The State of Utah currently uses the 2021 International Mechanical Code (IMC) as the basis for code enforcement. Critical to the IMC are the inclusion of SMACNA ANSI Accredited Standards covering duct construction, duct leakage, kitchen exhaust systems and fire/smoke dampers.

This session will instruct participants on the use and application of the following Standards covered in Chapters 4, 5 & 6 of the IMC:

- HVAC Duct Construction
- HVAC Air Duct Leakage
- HVAC Fire/Smoke Dampers
- Kitchen Grease Duct Fabrication

Additionally, changes to the 2024 International Mechanical Code (IMC) will be reviewed.
