### **Course Description**

This online course is based on the 2023 NEC and provides users a room-by-room walkthrough of a modern dwelling unit from the electrician's perspective. Using the 2023 NEC as their guide, licensees will be presented the general requirements for successfully assembling a dwelling unit electrical service, as well as minimum branch circuit requirements, receptacle outlet requirements, GFCI and AFCI protection requirements, lighting requirements, and special equipment and systems requirements for each room and the exterior of the dwelling unit.

### **Learning Objectives**

At the completion of the course, electricians will be able to:

- Organize the steps to building a NEC-compliant single-phase dwelling unit electrical service;
- List the NEC minimum branch circuit requirements for each room of a dwelling unit;
- Describe the receptacle outlet requirements per the NEC for each room of a dwelling unit;
- Apply GFCI and AFCI protection requirements to each room of a dwelling unit according to the NEC;
- Explain tamper-resistant receptacle technology and identify where the NEC requires these receptacles in each room of a dwelling unit;
- Apply NEC lighting outlet and control requirements to each room of a dwelling unit;
- Understand NEC special equipment and system requirements common to dwelling units;
- Meet the minimum electrical requirements for the exterior of a dwelling unit.

### **Equipment Requirements**

You must have an active, working internet connection to access this course online, as well as a platform to access the internet, such as a computer, tablet, or phone. All popular web browsers are supported, including Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Safari, and Opera. No specialized software, speaker, microphone, or web camera is required.
