Presentation Title: Got Water? Dewatering Permits Overview.

This presentation will review the Construction Dewatering and the Treated Groundwater General Permit. We will review the differences between the two permits and what projects should acquire a general permit to cover dewatering activities. The permit requirements, application process and monitoring procedures will be discussed for both the General Permits to provide a better understanding of how to navigate the permits. We will also review some basics of the EPA CDX site as the Construction Dewatering Hydrostatic Testing Permit has transitioned to this platform.
