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Understanding Safety on the Jobsite & How It Affects Your Work Comp Insurance!

In this class, we'll discuss the most common hazards you will run into on a jobsite, along with key safety strategies you can implement to improve the safety of your company's jobsite. We'll then discuss how a strong safe work environment and an understanding of your company's safety score will put dollars back in your pocket when dealing with your worker's compensation program!

- Objectives:
 - Demonstrate/give examples of: the types of common risks/hazards a contractor should be on the lookout for on their jobsites ("OSHA Focus 4").
 - Brainstorm: Ideas contractors can implement to ensure jobsite safety, especially when engaging with the OSHA Focus 4 (the 4 most common hazards on a jobsite).
 - Demonstrate: How a company's EMOD (safety score) affects a company's insurance premiums.
 - Demonstrate: The company's EMOD is really where the contractor has power over their insurance (work comp) costs.
 - Teach: How a contractor can implement safety practices and understanding of how an EMOD score is created to ensure best possible insurance premiums.
