

**SCHEDULE A ADDENDUM TO THE
SERVICE LEVEL AGREEMENT BETWEEN UTAH INTERACTIVE,
LLC
AND DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, DIVISION OF
PARKS AND RECREATION**

This document will serve as the latest Schedule A addendum to the Service Level Agreement with the Network manager, Utah Interactive, LLC, and Division of State Parks and Recreation (State Parks), subject to approval of the State of Utah Chief Information Office (CIO).

AGREEMENTS

1. Authorizes the Network Manager, to create a new, or make modifications to the existing State Parks website and information contained on that website at <http://www.stateparks.utah.gov/>, in accordance with this Agreement. Description of the website is as follows:

At the direction of State Parks, Utah Interactive will design and develop a new website to host the information contained on the existing State Parks website listed above.
2. Information Classification and User Access State Parks represents to the Network Manager the information included in the website and no private user access is required.
 - a. Costs. The Network Manager shall be responsible for costs and expenses associated with designing the website. Including, without limitation, the cost for purchasing or developing and maintaining all programs used to develop the website with State Parks. The website design by the Network Manager shall be prototyped and tested by the Network Manager and presented to State Parks to review and approve before it is offered to the public.
3. Payment and Collection.

A time and materials fee with an annual maintenance cost may be required to design, build, host and maintain this website.

Payment will be made in accordance to the signed Work order 030507.
4. Records and Finances. All documents and records maintained by the Network Manager relating to State Parks website shall be available for inspection, auditing and copying by the agency or other authorized representatives.
5. Funding Source. The Agency is required to declare in advance the source of funds used for this project (if any). Please indicate in the blank, which lettered statement is true about your funding source. If neither of these choices is true about your funding source, then the Network Manager may not be able to perform the work for the Agency. The Network Manager will rely upon your statement in determining whether it can or cannot perform this work for the Agency.
