

SCHEDULE A ADDENDUM TO THE SERVICE LEVEL AGREEMENT BETWEEN UTAH INTERACTIVE AND THE UTAH STATE TAX COMMISSION

This document will serve as the latest Schedule A addendum to the Service Level Agreement with the Utah State Tax Commission, Motor Vehicles Enforcement Division ("MVED") and Utah.gov ("The Network"), the state electronic government portal managed for the state by Utah Interactive Inc. ("Network Manager/UII") as an initiative of the State of Utah, to be approved by the Utah Electronic Commerce Council ("the Board") under the authority of the Utah Chief Information Officer, adding additional MVED transactions or services to the Network, subject to approval by the State of Utah.

MVED Purchasing Application

AGREEMENTS

1. Services by the Network Manager. MVED authorizes the Network Manager to enable electronic payments of monies to MVED, in accordance with this Addendum and the Agreement. Description of the services or transactions to be made available by the Network Manager pursuant to this Addendum are as follows:
 - a. Network Manager services will allow for the capture of payment information via the MVED's application interface and transmission of this information to the payment gateway for processing of payments to MVED. This service will use the Network's secure payment-processing infrastructure for online transactions. This infrastructure is comprised of a real-time credit card payment processing system.
 - b. Network Manger services include monitoring of the system and resolution of various issues that may arise.
 - c. Network Manager services include a nightly batch file containing detailed transaction information.

2. Record Classification and User Access Unless otherwise mutually agreed to in a written amendment to this Addendum signed by the Utah State Tax Commission and Utah Interactive, the Network Manager shall not provide access to any of MVED's Restricted Data. The Network Manager certifies that they will offer the following security and authorization for access to the application outlined above:

All online financial transactions use secure data transmission and a standard public-and-private key encryption system that encrypts the customer's submission of private financial data before it leaves their web browser. The data remains encrypted throughout transmission until it is safely received within the confines of the SSL where it is decrypted and processed. This SSL connection will exist only between the Network and The Utah State Tax Commission, MVED.

3. Record Supply Costs and Computer Programs. The Network Manager shall be responsible for costs and expenses in establishing access to the records and providing record transactions to Users and Administrators, including without limitation, the cost for purchasing or developing and maintaining all programs used to interface with the Utah State Tax Commission computer programs and to access the Records. Computer programs used by the Network Manager shall:
 - a. Protect information from unauthorized access;
 - b. Supply records to Administrators on a timely basis in an accurate, understandable and logical format acceptable to Utah State Tax Commission;

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4. Use messages. If required by the Managing Partner and participating agencies, the Network Manager shall cause the Network to require Users to signify online that they will comply with any restriction on use of the records required by law, as amended from time to time. Such user agreement will be in the form of a use message displayed online, with a required positive response, all as captured in a log file, prior to the User being permitted to further search or view the record.
5. Subscriber Agreements. This service will not require Network Subscriber agreements.
6. Transaction Logs. MVED shall have access to the Network's transaction log (the "Log") for the purpose of auditing the collection and/or dissemination of MVED transaction records. Unless otherwise specified by MVED, this Log shall contain the following data: User name, transaction data and time and type of inquiry/transaction.
7. Payment and Collection. A subscription to the Network will not be required to access the MVED Permit Purchasing Application, but a Network transaction charge shall be payable to the Network by MVED.
 - a. Collection: The total cost to the Users for permits shall be variable and set by The Utah State Tax Commission, MVED. The Network Manager may not charge any additional amounts for the identified Services without prior written agreement from the Utah State Tax Commission, which agreement shall require approval by the State of Utah.

Each transaction will incur a fee to be paid by the Utah State Tax Commission, MVED to UII. The fee charged by the Network represents a fee for development and support services. The Network hereby represents to The Utah State Tax Commission, MVED that it believes the following charges will fairly and reasonably recompense the Network Manager for the Services:

- b. Payment: The purchasing application facilitates real-time authentication of purchases. Proceeds from completed credit card transactions will be directly deposited to the MVED's account through the credit card processor in real time or in a nightly batch. All revenue collected through the automatic payment system will be processed and deposited into MVED's account within forty-eight hours from the time of transaction. The Network will tally each transaction and invoice the Utah State Tax Commission on a monthly basis for the Network transaction charge.
8. Records and Finances. All Network documents and records maintained by the Network Manager relating to MVED purchases shall be available for inspection, auditing and copying by MVED or other authorized representatives.
9. Efficiency Gain Calculation. MVED and the Network will establish baseline cost for the purchasing of dealer permits both prior to making the enhanced service available and after the service is made available to estimate the cost savings of offering this service.

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
